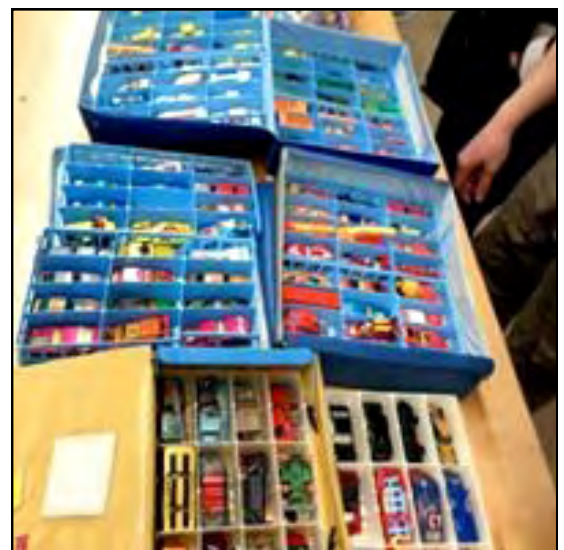

Let's Cruise the Barn Quilt Trail—meet at Turner's Inn on Sunday, May 21st at 12:30 p.m.

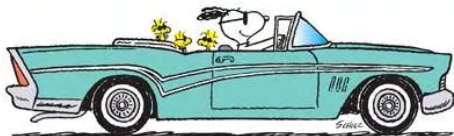

First we eat! We'll meet at the Turner Inn at 460 County Route 2 phone # 315-375-4020 at 12:30 p.m. The Cruisers Car Club is paying for lunch for paid members — have you paid your dues for 2017?

Here's how to get to the Turner Inn, from Ogdensburg go west on Route 37 to Morristown, turn left on Route 58 south to Route 2 (Potatoe Street Road) you can't miss it. If it's sunny I hope to see a lot of old cars, but if it's rainy it's ok to drive newer cars (we go rain or shine).

After lunch we'll have a short meeting and then cruise the Hammond Barn Quilt Trail ([www.hammondbarnquilttrail.wordpress.com](http://www.hammondbarnquilttrail.wordpress.com)) . When visiting the trail, please use caution when slowing or stopping to take pictures. Quilt blocks located on private property should be viewed only from the road. Be considerate and please use caution.
